THE GREEN CORNER

WELCOMING SUMMER THE GREEN WAY!

Here are low-tech & green ways to keep your body and your home cool:

- Stay hydrated. Avoid caffeine in the heat as these can promote dehydration. Drink more water than usual or consider an electrolyte replacement drink if you're sweating a lot.
- Cool off with water. Soak your feet in a tub of cold water or put on a wet bandana. Keep a spray bottle of water in the refrigerator and spritz yourself regularly throughout the day.
- Use windows and curtains to your advantage. If you're not home during the day, close all windows & curtains to keep your house cool. If you're home and don't want all the windows covered, cover them only when needed. As a tip, west-facing windows get the hotter and stronger sun in the afternoon. Dark-colored curtains can be very effective, and roller shades can block up to 80% of solar heat.
- Don't add to the heat inside. Use appliances such as irons and washers at night or early morning. Turn off computers and other appliances when not in use as these can also generate unnecessary heat if left running. Unplug appliances when not in use to reduce your electric bill as well.
